- Scanned review of the doctor / candidate (in the format *.jpg, *.png).

Create the application file in Word and save in one of the formats: *.doc, *.docx, *.rtf. The file should be named by the name of the author of the article. The author's name should be written in Latin, for example, **zayavka_Ivaniv.doc**.

Create an electronic version of the article in Word editor and save in one of the formats: *.doc, *.docx, *.rtf. The file should be named by the number of the thematic direction and the name of the author of the article, for example, **2_Ivaniv.doc**. Scanned reviews should be named by the surname for example, **recenziia_Ivaniv.doc**.

Participation in the conference is free.

An electronic version of the collection will be published based on the conference materials. The participants will receive an electronic version of the certificate.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN OF MATERIALS

Text should be typed in Word editor: font Times New Roman, size 14 pt, line spacing spacing 1.5. Margins: left - 2.5 cm, right – 2 cm, top - 2.0 cm, bottom - 2 cm.

Materials should be submitted in the following sequence:

1. Formatting - bold font, alignment on the the left edge.
2. The first line in the center: the title of the report - in capital letters, bold.
3. Second line in the center: Full name of the participant.
4. Third line in the center: place of study.
5. Annotations and keywords in Ukrainian and English (before the text, in italics).
6. The text of the manuscript should contain the following elements:
 - Statement of the problem in general form, and its connection with important scientific or practical tasks.
 - Analysis of recent research and publications, where the tasks of this problem were solved, identification of previously unresolved parts of the general problem to which the article is devoted.
 - The purpose of the article.
 - Statement of the problem.
 - Presentation of the main research material with justification of the scientific results obtained.
 - Conclusions - the result of this study and prospects for further developments.
 - Literature.
7. The list of references should be added after the text of the article. Description of literary sources is carried out according to established requirements (see the Bulletin of HAC of Ukraine. №5. 2009). References to the used literature sources are mandatory.
8. Examples in the text of the article should be given in italics, key words should be underlined. References to examples of illustrative material is obligatory.

Articles that do not meet the requirements, scientific level and topics of the conference, as well as sent later than the deadline, will not be considered. Articles are mandatorily checked for plagiarism.
